



# Sampling & Hand-washing Station Policy

## Health Inspectors

Your organization IS NOT required to file a temporary food permit, but Inspectors will be present over the dates of the tradeshow (July 15 & 16) to ensure that your company's booth follows the St. Louis Health District regulations. The health department reserves the right to shut down individual booths that are not in compliance with the regulations.

## Sampling Form & Hand-washing Station

Those companies serving food and beverage items are required to complete a [Sampling Authorization Form & the Health Department Information Form](#) and they MUST have a temporary hand-washing station located within their booth.

You have the option of assembling your own [hand-washing station photo \(click here to view\)](#) or renting a [Portable Hand-washing Unit](#) at the cost of \$75, plus tax from Levy Restaurants & Catering Services.

If your company is sampling a pre-packaged item, you are not required to have a temporary hand-washing station. But once you open that item (divide into parts to give as a food sample), you are required to have a hand-washing station.

## Food Samples
