
















Exam Mindset

 <p>National vs State Perspective</p>	 <p>Put on a director/ operator cap.</p>	 <p>Think broadly.</p>
 <p>Answer all questions.</p>	 <p>Stuck? Don't dwell on something you do not know. Mark and return.</p>	 <p>Look for key words (e.g., best, most, first).</p>
 <p>Write in test book.</p>	 <p>Pick the best answer.</p>	 <p>Mark out wrong answers.</p>
 <p>Read the question and only what is in the question.</p>	 <p>Answer questions that you are confident in first.</p>	 <p>Ignore others. Work at your own pace.</p>
 <p>Cover up the answers.</p>	 <p>Slow down.</p>	 <p>Write out calculations.</p>
