08.31.2015 Comment Request on SBP Record Collection

The USDA has [posted notification](#) of request for comments on their proposed School Breakfast Program record collection. USDA's Food and Nutrition Service (FNS) requires States, SFAs and schools to keep accounts and records as may be necessary to determine whether the program is in compliance. SFAs collect information and provide it to their State agencies who in turn report back to FNS. Comments are invited on whether the collection of information is necessary and efficient and can be sent to Desk Officer for Agriculture, Office of Information and Regulatory Affairs, Office of Management and Budget (OMB), OIRA_Submission@omb.eop.gov, or faxed to (202) 395-5806 and are due by September 30, 2015.

08.25.2015 USDA 2015 Dietary Guidelines Communications

The U.S. Department of Agriculture is asking for your input on how to better inform the public about its upcoming 2015 Dietary Guidelines. In this [Federal Register notice](#), the Center for Nutrition Policy and Promotion requests permission from the Office of Management and Budget for this information collection and asks the public for commentary on whether the proposed collection of information is necessary and effective. Information collected will be used to further develop the Dietary Guidelines and related communications.
