## DIY Student-signed Apron Craft

Give your School Lunch Hero a memorable and personalized gift from the student who love them. Follow these instructions for a quick and easy craft.

## What You Need:

- <u>Lunch Hero White Apron (SKU#: SLD18)</u> from <u>SNA Shop</u> OR a plain white apron
- Fabric markers or permanent markers
- Cardboard or thick paper
- Students! (of course)

## Instructions:

- 1. First, purchase the <u>Lunch Hero White Apron</u> from <u>SNA Shop</u> or a plain white apron.
- 2. Lay the apron flat on a table or surface.
- 3. Cut a piece of cardboard or thick paper to fit inside the apron, so that the marker ink won't bleed through to the back of the apron.
- 4. Place the cardboard or paper inside the apron, making sure it is secure and flat.
- 5. Provide fabric or permanent markers to the students who will be signing the apron. You can choose colors that match your school's colors or let the students choose their own colors.
- 6. Have the students sign their names on the apron using the markers. You can also encourage them to write positive messages or draw pictures for their School Lunch Hero.
- 7.Once all the students have signed the apron, allow the ink to dry completely. This may take a few hours, depending on the type of marker used.
- 8. Remove the cardboard or paper from inside the apron.
- 9. Your apron is ready to be given to your School Lunch Hero. Don't forget to thank them for all the hard work they do every day!

Note: If you want the signatures to be more permanent, you can heat-set them with an iron according to the marker manufacturer's instructions. This will help to ensure that the signatures won't fade or wash away over time.
