THE LORE OF NATIONAL SCHOOL LUNCH WEEK





This act established the National School Lunch Program (NSLP) and paved the way for other vital federal child nutrition initiatives, including school breakfast, afterschool snacks, summer feeding, farm-to-school and more.

After 77 years, the School Nutrition Association (SNA)

remains a strong advocate for thousands of school nutrition professionals who now serve breakfast, lunch, snack, supper and weekend meals throughout the school year and summer.

National School Lunch Week

(NSLW) was introduced by Congress and President John F. Kennedy in 1962. It is an annual celebration that emphasizes the importance of healthy school lunches for K-12 students

LEVEL I:

Plan Your Strategies

To kickstart an extraordinary #NSLW23, begin by looking back at previous celebrations and dedicating time to craft a comprehensive outline for your festivities this year. Dive into the journaling prompts below, ensuring every aspect of the celebration is well-planned.



Brainstorming

Ponder some ideas for this year's "Level Up with School Lunch" theme. What aspects of nutritious school meals and video can you weave together to make it engaging and exciting?



Goal-Setting

Define specific benchmarks for your #NSLW23 celebration. What do you want to accomplish by celebrating #NSLW23? Is it increased student participation in school lunch programs, promoting healthier meal choices or raising awareness about the importance of school meals (or all three?)





Budget Planning

Determine your funds available for the celebration. How can you allocate funds to different aspects of the event, such as decorations, activities and promotional materials? Don't forget to factor in the free resources that SNA offers!



Event Timeline

Create a loose schedule for the #NSLW23 celebration. When will you start preparations, and what tasks need to be completed each week leading up to the event?

SIDE QUEST #I: ASK THE KIDS!

In developing your celebration plans, focus on a generic video game aesthetic (taking cues from the retro style of the official #NSLW23 logo), but consider doing some research into games and characters that are popular with your students. Conduct a poll, asking students as they come through the serving line or while they're dining in the cafeteria to share their favorites. With this insight in hand, you can lean into those games with your decoration and celebration ideas. It can help the students feel involved in the event and make it more relatable to your school site. One word of caution about artwork: Remember that most games and characters are protected by copyrights and trademarks. Be sure you use officially licensed merchandise to stay in the clear!

LEVEL 2:

Your Mission Log: Make Sure You Check Everything Off!

Prepare for an epic #NSLW23 adventure with this handy mission log checklist that will guide you through every step of the planning process. Check off each task to ensure a successful and unforgettable "Level Up with School Lunch" celebration!

Alert the school principal(s) and other leaders about your plans and secure any required permissions.
Gather your team for a meeting to discuss responsibilities and finalize the timeline.
Download and share the sample <u>proclamation</u> with your city council or mayor's office.
Issue <u>custom press releases</u> to special guests, media representatives or legislators visiting your cafeteria.
Kickstart promotion by using SNA's Social Media Kit to spread the excitement of #NSLW23 to students and the community.
Encourage team members to dress up on designated days and provide guidelines on appropriate attire during food preparation and service.
Plan to deck out the serving lines and dining area with a captivating gaming theme. Compile a list of ideas, props and supplies, and assign someone responsible for acquiring or creating these items.

1. Yoshi's Egg Salad Sandwiches


Prepare egg salad sandwiches and cut them into oval shapes to resemble Yoshi's eggs from the Super Mario series.

Prepare spicy chicken wings and call them "Fire Flower Wings" after the power-up in "Super Mario."




6. Animal Crossing Fruit Salad

9. "Fortnite" Shield Potion Smoothies


Blend blueberries, bananas, and yogurt to create refreshing smoothies inspired by the shield potions in "Fortnite."







SUIT UP FOR ADVENTURE:

Add excitement to the Cafeteria with Costumes!

Get ready to level up your cafeteria celebrations with these fantastic video game character costume ideas. We know how much you love to dress up, and that's why we've curated this collection of iconic video game characters that will bring an extra dose of fun and excitement. From classic heroes like Mario and Link to beloved characters like Pikachu and Sonic the Hedgehog, these costumes are sure to make your school lunch experience truly epic.

1. Mario or Luigi ("Super Mario")

Wear blue overalls, with a red longsleeved shirt and a red cap with an "M" on it for Mario or a green long-sleeved shirt and a green cap with an "L" on it for Luigi. Create a fake mustache using black construction paper or felt and attach it to your upper lip.

3. Pikachu ("Pokémon")

Dress in a yellow onesie or all-yellow clothing. Add Pikachu's iconic red cheeks using red face paint or cut out red circles from felt and stick them on your cheeks. Wear Pikachu ears or make them using cardboard and headbands.

5. Sonic the Hedgehog

Wear a blue jumpsuit or hoodie with spikes made from blue felt or foam attached to the back. Add red or white gloves and Sonic's red shoes.

Embark on an epic #NSLW23 quest, by inviting national legislators to witness the importance of a healthy school lunch. Check with your local school officials to help determine the feasibility and parameters of these special visits.

Here's your strategy guide:

1. Plan Ahead

Start organizing media events and legislator visits well in advance of National School Lunch Week (NSLW). Reach out to local media outlets and legislators early to secure their availability and commitment to attend.



If the event is approved, be well-prepared, as guests may have tight schedules. Create a detailed agenda for each media event and legislator visit. Outline the activities, key talking points and photo opportunities to make the most of their time at your school.

2. Coordinate with District Communication Team

Work closely with your school district's communication team to ensure that all media events and legislator visits comply with district policies and guidelines on filming children. They can help to reach out to bloggers, news producers and reporters from local papers and news stations to promote #NSLW23.

4. Showcase School Lunch Success Stories

Prepare success stories, testimonials and key data about your school lunch program to share with the media and legislators. Illustrate how nutritious meals positively impact students and the community.









5. Prepare Media Kits

Assemble all the important documents you'll need such as the SNA customizable press release, fact sheets (such as the financial impact on your program and staff), high-quality images and other relevant information about NSLW and your school lunch program. Provide these kits to media representatives during their visit.

6. Capture Moments

Assign a team member to capture photos and videos of the events. Documenting the visits and media coverage will be valuable for future promotions and reports.



7. Follow Up

Show gratitude by sending thank you notes to all involved, including media representatives and legislators who attended. Provide them with any additional information they may need and express gratitude for their support.

Even if you cannot arrange a visit by state or national legislators, you can still download the #NSLW23 Official Proclamation, customize it with your details and request local authorities like mayors, city council chairs, county executives or district superintendents to recognize October 9-13, 2023, as National School Lunch Week!



Get Crafty with Fuse Bead Creations!

This step-by-step guide will show you how to create adorable pixel art using fuse beads to decorate your cafeteria, use it as prizes or involve students in the craft! Fuse bead crafts are a fantastic way to immerse yourself in the pixelated charm of classic and modern games while unleashing your artistic prowess. So, grab your pegboards, gather your beads and let's embark together on this simple craft. Looking for design inspiration? Check out our NSLW24 Pinterest boards for patterns and ideas!

Materials Needed:

- A pack of fuse (or Perler) beads in various colors (these can be found at craft stores like Michaels or online stores like Amazon)
- Pegboards (typically included in the fuse bead kits)
- Ironing paper
- Iron



Step 1: Choose Your Design

Select a video game character, symbol or item that you want to recreate with fuse beads. You can find pixel art patterns online or create your own design!

Step 2: Place Fuse Beads on Pegboard

Lay out the pegboard and place the fuse beads on it, following the design you've chosen. Be careful to arrange the beads precisely to create a pixelated look.

Step 3: Ironing Preparation

Once your design is complete on the pegboard, place a sheet of ironing paper or parchment paper over the beads to protect them during the ironing process.







Step 4: Iron the Beads



Preheat the iron to a medium setting (check the beads package for specific instructions). Carefully iron the beads with a gentle circular motion, making sure each bead fuses and sticks together. Avoid pressing too hard, as it may cause the beads to deform.

Step 5: Cooling and Removal
