

Certificate holders may move from one level to another by earning the additional academic requirements or key area training required for the next level.

- College courses can be used regardless of how many years ago they were taken
- Certificates of completion cannot be dated more than five years back
- Documents used to meet the initial certificate program level cannot be used to move up to another level with the exception of the 8 hour Core Course in Food Safety & Sanitation (taken in the last 5 years)

- 2. 6 hours in Key Area 2 Operations
- 3. 6 hours in Key Area 3 Administration
- 4. 6 hours in Key Area 4 Communications & Marketing

- 6. High School Diploma OR GED

- 1. 15 hours in Key Area 1 Nutrition
- 2. 15 hours in Key Area 2 Operations

- 6. High School Diploma OR GED
