A Membership Champion is passionate about promoting SNA membership and comfortable speaking to fellow colleagues about it. The position's responsibilities may also include:


- Reaching out to target potential members to promote the benefits of membership.

LEARN ABOUT STATE ASSOCIATIONS

What are state associations or affiliates?

SNA's state affiliates are vital to championing student nutrition at the state level. For 70 years, SNA state affiliates have been working together with SNA to ensure that well-nourished students across the country are prepared for success.

How does a state become an SNA affiliate?

The state association partnership with the national association is formalized through the <u>State Affiliation</u> <u>Agreement</u> to ensure mutual benefits for both organizations.

How does SNA National Support its state affiliates?

- State Support Center: A one-stop-shop for state
 affiliate resources, including Membership Resources like
 the latest membership reports, recordings of past
 membership meet-ups, state certificate templates, and
 more.
- The State Support Center also hosts regional town halls and seasonal membership meet-ups for additional opportunities for state leaders to provide support to one another.
- National Leadership Conference: Held annually in April, the National Leadership Conference (NLC) is tailored exclusively for state association leaders to learn, network and build leadership skills.
- National Leadership State Visits: SNA provides for SNA National Board members to attend 12 state affiliate meetings every year at SNA national's expense. This means, a state affiliate can have an in-person visit every four (4) years from an SNA Board member.
