How It All Began

They might not fly or have superpowers (or maybe they do—we wouldn't be surprised!), but there's no question that school foodservice workers are heroes. That's why SNA loves collaborating with children's author and illustrator Jarrett J. Krosoczka, creator of the Lunch Lady graphic novel series, to celebrate School Lunch Hero Day year after year. This year marks the 13th anniversary of this special observance recognizing the hard work school nutrition professionals do every day.

"School Lunch Hero Day has far

exceeded my hopes and vision for what the celebration could be," Krosoczka once said. "It has become a huge annual party, which means the world to me."

It all started when Krosoczka released his Lunch Lady books in 2009, reimagining the familiar figure of the cafeteria worker as a crime-fighting vigilante spy. Kids immediately connected with the humor, adventure and heart of the stories—seeing a part of their everyday world in a new light.

During the years he was writing the series, Krosoczka teamed up with SNA to officially launch the first School Lunch Hero

Day in 2012. Since then, the celebration has grown far beyond what he could have imagined.

Over the years, SNA and Krosoczka have witnessed incredible celebrations

firsthand—like the time Houston Independent School District students lined the hallways with artwork, poetry and thank-you notes, capped off by a Broadway-style production honoring their cafeteria teams.

For Krosoczka, the mission is personal. His own school cafeteria staff inspired him as a child, and he's never forgotten their kindness. In fact, he invited his former lunch ladies to the *Lunch Lady* book launch—and was deeply moved when they shared how

much they loved every student who passed through their lunch line.

Through the *Lunch Lady* series and School Lunch Hero Day, Krosoczka has pushed back against tired media stereotypes of cafeteria workers, instead shining

a light on their compassion, hard work and importance to school communities. He's even created a new, more inclusive group of characters in the *Lunch Lady* universe to better reflect the diversity of today's real-life lunch heroes.

And the story doesn't stop there! The original *Lunch Lady* books have been reissued in full-color editions, and a full-cast audiobook is also available (featuring **Kate Flannery** from *The Office* as the *Lunch Lady*!).

As we gear up for this year's celebration on May 2, it's clear that School Lunch Hero Day is about more than one moment. It's about

recognizing a year (and really, a career) of small, everyday heroics: the extra encouragement for a student who needs it, the careful attention to a child's dietary needs, the daily commitment to ensuring kids have what they need to succeed.
